



## **HASKELL COUNTY JUSTICE OF THE PEACE**

Per Government Code 81.01, "The Haskell County Justice of the Peace Office cannot give advice or give any service requiring the use of legal skill or knowledge such as providing or preparing any legal document or court document". You may either contact an attorney or do your own research to conduct legal matters.

What do I need to apply for an Occupational Driver's License in Haskell County?

1. Petition for Occupational Driver's License
2. Order granting the Occupational Driver License
3. SR-22 Insurance Form
4. Copy of Driving Record from DPS
5. Copy of Criminal History from DPS
6. Filing fee of \$54.00 (Non-Refundable)
